# **Religionless Christianity**

Matthew 15:8-9 These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. They worship me in vain; their teachings are but rules taught by men.

Dietrich Bonhoeffer coined the phrase "religionless Christianity". He lived in Germany during the rise of Hitler and the Nazis. Bonhoeffer was disturbed by lack of thinking, lack of conviction and lack of action by the church (used in a very general sense in this article). Churches and Christians pledged their support for Hitler and signed the Aryan agreement. If one was not an Aryan, then they were considered a lower form of life and this is why so many Jews were executed. The church was told not to teach from the Old Testament because it was Jewish. The church by and large was in agreement and turned a blind eye to all the evils of that time. Bonhoeffer did all he could to oppose the evils of the day and ended up being hung just days before Hitler killed himself.

Bonhoeffer referred to Christians in Germany as either "confessing Christians" or "religionless Christians". Confessing Christians would stand their ground for the entire Bible; they would confront evil and by their lives they would confess that Jesus Christ was Lord. Religionless Christians did not steal, murder or commit adultery; they did some good but they would not open their eyes and ears to the injustice and evil around them. They would not get involved in opposing evil. Which of these two categories do we fall into? Are we Christian in name only or are we confessing Jesus with the way we live our lives? Jesus warned that lip service will not suffice. Following the rules of men is not following Christ. Christ must have our hearts and this must lead to actions that show our deep beliefs. The hangman said he never saw a man calmly face death as Bonhoeffer did. Bonhoeffer believed he would close his eyes here and instantly open them to meet the Lord. Are we living our faith?
