Healing hands International (HHI) is an international aid group connected with the Churches of Christ. They try to make an impact upon people throughout the world by helping to meet their needs through clothing, hygiene products, medical care, food, clean water, etc. . . and most importantly teaching them the gospel of Jesus Christ.

One such unique project the Making A God Impact project (MAGI). This effort began in 2003 and has grown tremendously every year since. The purpose of the MAGI project is to fill a box with a list of items (e.g., soap, toothbrushes, Bibles, underwear) and add to it a few extras such as coloring books, small toys, etc. . . then have it sent to a needy child in one of several foreign countries. This box is distributed around Christmas time and of course acts as a much needed Christmas gift for a child.

When I first heard about this project, I was very interested in not only doing my own part but also offering the opportunity for the others to be a part of this great work. Twenty-five boxes were sent to South Gate last week along with brochures explaining more of the details. So far several boxes have been taken but there are more to fill. Along with a filled up box, a \$7.00 donation to cover the international shipping costs is requested. Because these are shipped thousands at a time, the requested donation is much cheaper than you could personally send it yourself. The dead line for the final pick up time is October 1. I hope you will take part in this wonderful endeavor and help Make A God Impact in the life of someone else that you others would never have had the opportunity to reach.

How Much Do You Talk?

Proverbs 10:19 When words are many, sin is not absent, but he who holds his tongue is wise.

Solomon, the wisest of all men, said much about wisdom within the book of Proverbs. A great many of his proverbs dealt with the use of the tongue. This particular thought provides us with a great warning. When words are many, then sin is not absent. In other words, the more we talk the greater the chance of us using our tongue for sinful purposes. The tongue can do many things that are sinful.
