Over the past forty years, every second weekend in June and second weekend in September, an event known as the Diana Singing has taken place. What began as the love of congregational singing by a few brethren has grown into a major event each year. During the weeks leading up to this many people will bring their campers and campout while helping prepare things for the singing. Thousands of people come from literally all around the world to this event. This past Friday night my family and I took the opportunity to go for the first time. While there we heard the roll call of sates. People representing twenty-nine states were present along with people from three foreign countries, England, Scotland and Australia. The youngest person there was two weeks old and the oldest man and woman were both ninety-one.

Perhaps the most impressive number of all was the total present for this event. The official final count was 3,784 people. How impressive it was and is to see and be part of such a group. It was encouraging to know so many people were willing to gather on a Friday night to sing praises to God. It is my understanding this is an average size crowd for the September singing and during the summer the numbers are higher. And, let's not forget the singing was great too.

Every time the church gathers together, we always sing. It is easy for this to become so common place, especially when the song is very familiar. However, singing is an incredible part of our worship. It is one of the things we all do together. It is intended to be instructive, encouraging, uplifting and filled with praise for God (Eph. 5:19; Col .3:16). It is offered up a sacrifice to God (Heb. 13:15). It will set the tone for worship. Nothing can pull a worship service down like bad or mutter, half hearted singing, while enthusiastic, heart felt singing builds it up. It is unfortunate as I look out over the crowds and see a number of people with mouths closed and/or minds elsewhere. I know some do not feel comfortable singing or cannot sing well but God still said sing and never said anything about how great it sounds. Instead, He is listening to the sounds resonating from the heart. Is yours fill with I cannot wait to leave? Is yours filled with guilt and pain? Is yours filled with coldness or deadness? Or, is yours filled with love, praise, joy and happiness?
