Mocking

Luke 22:63 The men who were guarding Jesus began mocking and beating him.

Judas Iscariot betrayed Jesus; Peter denied knowing Jesus. Today we read that men mocked and beat the Lord. In every society, an element of evil men who enjoy harming people is found. As Jesus said at his arrest, there are times "when darkness reigns". Jesus was seen by these people as simply a man who they believed to be a criminal. They were having fun at his expense. Their enjoyment came by mocking the Lord, beating the Lord and insulting the Lord. Part of the mocking procedure was to blindfold Jesus and then someone hit him and asked that he identify the one that hit him. Do you realize that Jesus really did know who hit him? He really did know who mocked him. He was enduring some of the evils of society and no part of it was pleasant. How sinful for men to shamefully treat the one and only who has lived the perfect, sinless life.

This passage should cause us to stop and ask ourselves how we are treating the Son of God. Many men today mock the Lord, his sacrifice, his church and his followers. Many throw insults towards him and certainly many insult his name by using it as slang or in a cursing manner. Often this occurs due to ignorance. Many do not know who Jesus is or simply refuse to believe he is the Son of God. Sometimes Christians can bring insult to the Lord by the way they live. How sad it is to see how our Lord was treated. May we do all to teach people the identity of the Lord. May we teach people to show him respect instead of the shameful behavior in today's verses. May all we do bring him glory and honor
