A Great Separation....By Joe Macer

Matthew 13:47 Once again, the kingdom of heaven is like a net that was let down into the lake and caught all kinds of fish.

Several of the disciples of Jesus were fishermen. Much of the fishing was done on the Sea of Galilee. The fishing was not with a pole and a line but with a net. The net was lowered into the water and as the net was tightened fish were caught. A vast variety of fish were taken. Some of these were valuable to the fisher and were sold for their income. Other fish were taken that had no value whatsoever. These fish were either tossed back or they were destroyed. In our lifetime each one has had many opportunities to examine an object and make the determination as to whether the object was beneficial or useless. This is the message behind this parable.

In the parable, the good fish were collected and placed in a basket. The bad fish were thrown away. What was the lesson taught by the Lord? The message is not about fish but about people. At the end of the age, angels will come and separate the wicked from the righteous. Not much is said about the righteous in this parable but the wicked will have a terrible outcome. The wicked will be thrown into a fiery furnace where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

This message of separation is taught many times throughout the Scriptures. Sheep will be separated from the goats and the weeds will be separated from the wheat. A separation of the righteous and the wicked will take place. Which side will the Lord find us on? Will we be found righteous or wicked? Make the most of life's opportunities to be found right with the Lord. This decision has eternal consequences.
