Revelation 16:15 Behold, I come like a thief! Blessed is he who stays awake and keeps his clothes with him, so that he may not go naked and be shamefully exposed.

This is the third blessing delivered in the book of Revelation. These are the words of Jesus. While on earth and now in heaven he proclaimed his second coming. The second coming will be like a thief. A thief comes when unexpected and he certainly does not announce when he will come. Will the Christian be prepared and watching? The previous verse and the following verse are dealing with battles. The soldier had the responsibility while on watch to stay awake and prepared for battle. What a disaster if the soldier is asleep when he should be watching and if he is dressed for bed rather than battle. During the days of the temple, if an officer found a temple guard sleeping he was allowed to set his clothes on fire. What a great embarrassment to have your clothes destroyed. What is the blessing? The blessing is for the Christian who stays awake and keeps his clothes with him. Christians are to watch for the Lord's return and they are to watch that they keep their lives free from sin. The Christian should be wearing their robes of white maintaining purity. This verse reminds us of the parable of the ten virgins. The five foolish virgins were not prepared for the bridegroom's return and the result was disastrous. They not only looked foolish but they were not allowed in to the wedding. How blessed we are when we live each moment of our life in great concern for serving the Lord.
