Revelation 19:9 Then the angel said to me, "Write: 'Blessed are those who are invited to the wedding supper of the Lamb!' And he added, "These are the true words of God."

Will there be eating in heaven? People not only find eating necessary but also enjoyable. We like to be at a table no matter how fancy the meal with those we love and care about. I don't know if there will be literal eating in heaven but heaven itself will be a feast for our soul. Jesus talked about a feast with Abraham, Isaac and Jacob in the kingdom of heaven. Today's verse talks about a wedding supper given for the Lamb. Blessed are those who are invited to this wedding supper. Who is or has been invited to this meal?

This verse sounds much like the parable given by the Lord in Luke 14. In this account Jesus said, "Blessed is the man who will eat at the feast in the kingdom of heaven."
