Last week, as I taught the combined Bible Classes on Wednesday, I continued the discussion of loving God and loving others (Mt. 22:36-4). As part of this broad discussion, I talked about the people Jesus literally invited to the table (e.g., the tax collectors, prostitutes and sinners). For each of us to love God and love others, I challenged us to do the same by inviting everyone to the table and making it known what Jesus has to offer.

The great challenge I set forth was the fact we can never truly love others outside the church and bring them to the table if we don't first love those within the church. Each of us need to take the time, opportunity and efforts to speak to engage others, especially those who are not part of our immediate group. It only takes a few seconds to stick your hand out, say hello and begin a conversation. It is amazing how many things you find you have in common with others just by talking with them for a few minutes.

Another aspect of this is how we make our visitors feel welcomed and how long. Each of us should take it on ourselves to greet every visitor. Imagine the welcome and sense of belonging this would produce. Additionally, we need to greet each other. Make it known you are happy to see them. When we all do a little it helps a lot.

Everyone likes to know they are wanted and included. Many responded so readily to Jesus because He made them feel this way. Imagine what will happen if we did the same here at South Gate to visitors and each other?
