5 And seeing the multitudes, He went up on a mountain, and when He was seated His disciples came to Him. ² Then He opened His mouth and taught them, saying:

A New Life

Acts 5:20 "Go, stand in the temple courts," he said, "and tell the people the full message of this new life."

The Apostles were obedient to the commands of the Lord Jesus Christ. They were in the process of teaching people in the city of Jerusalem the gospel. Many men and women believed due to their preaching and were added to the church. At the time they were meeting with success they began to be attacked. Some Sadducees decided to put a stop to their preaching. The Apostles were arrested and placed in jail but that night an angel of the Lord opened the door of the prison. They were told to go back to the temple courts and proclaim the message that they were just arrested for proclaiming. At daybreak they were doing that very thing.

What were they told to preach? First they were told to preach the full message. This is no different than Jesus stated before he ascended. The disciples were to teach all things that he had commanded. The full message must be preached and the full message must be obeyed by the listeners. The part of the message to be stressed was the new life. Christianity was different from what they had grown up living. It was a totally different life style. This they were to present to the people.
