The Motives of Men. . . By Joe Macer

I Corinthians 4:5 Therefore judge nothing before the appointed time; wait till the Lord comes. He will bring to light what is hidden in darkness and will expose the motives of men's hearts. At that time each will receive his praise from God.

Simply put, we are to stop judging. Many acts of men are obvious. If we catch someone stealing, then we know the person is guilty. If we observed someone bowing down to worship an idol then we know they are an idolater. Jesus taught that we can judge a tree by its fruit. What we cannot do is to judge the motives of why people do the things we do. Many false accusations were leveled against Paul. Paul knew that no one but the Lord could really judge him. These accusers might believe they knew why Paul did what he did but the truth is they did not. Paul understood what he was doing and why he did it but he would not even judge himself. All judgment is left up to God. People do not have sufficient information or competence to judge one another.

There is an appointed time for God to do the judging. Scriptures refer to it as the Judgment Day. This is the day in which we will receive what is due for the things done in the body. This judgment is the only judgment that matters. The Hebrew writer informs us that the word of God will judge the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. Jesus told some Pharisees that "God knows your heart." The day of judgment will not only expose things that people thought they had hidden but the motives of men's hearts will be made known. On that day we will know the truth about all matters. Judgment belongs to the Lord and we would be ever so wise if we will live in such a way as to receive praise from God. Are your actions and motive proper?
