I John 2:12 *I write to you, dear children, because your* sins have been forgiven on account of his name.

John listed several reasons within his letter as to why he had written the letter. Three different categories of people are listed in these three verses. We should consider these as we read and study this book. These are lessons for us as well

John wrote to the dear children. These are Christians that he played a role in their conversion. First he wanted them to never forget that as a child of God their sins were forgiven. This is true down to this day for us as well. Their sins were forgiven on account of Jesus. Secondly, he wrote to the children because they had known the Father. They were living the Christian life.

John also addressed the older men. He refers to them as fathers. This is not in a religious sense but in terms of spiritual age of these men. They know him who is from the beginning. Again, this is a reference to Christ. Christ has been from the beginning of creation. These men know the Lord. These men have now been serving him for years. Each of should grow to maturity in our service of the Lord.

The third group of individuals addressed was the young men. First these men had overcome the evil one. They have given up their evil ways and have dedicated their lives to Jesus Christ. He also states these young men have the word of God living in them. The key to overcoming is to have God's word in our hearts and minds. These young men have become strong. How is your Christ life progressing? Whether young or old, let's draw closer to him.

Surveying the Cross

When I survey the wondrous cross on which the Prince of glory died, my richest gain I count but loss, and pour contempt on all my pride.

Sir Isaac Watts penned these words in 1704 in England around the age of 22. I have always loved this song as it challenges each one of us to examine the cross of our Lord. A cruel torturous instrument of execution that has come to symbolize for so many the love of our Lord. When is the last time you seriously and deeply surveyed the cross of Jesus?

When we look at His cross we can not leave the same. I believe we are either drawn to it to cling to the love it represented, or we become hardened and move farther away from our God. A person can not be neutral on the cross of Jesus Christ. Two of Paul's statements on the cross are the source of great insight.

I Corinthians 1:18 For the word of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

Galatians 6:14 But may it never be that I would boast, except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.

Paul tells us two things to consider in these passages as we survey the cross. One, it is the power of God to salvation to all believers. Two, when we cling to the Cross we must leave the world behind. I can't wait to look at the cross with each of you Sunday morning. Make sure to be here and invite a friend!
