### Talking or Working?... By Joe Macer

Proverbs 14:23 All hard work brings a profit, but mere talk leads only to poverty.

The book of Proverbs often compares the hard working person and the lazy person. This verse compares the hard worker and the talker. Have you met the individual that is always talking about the next major undertaking and the vast amount of money to be made but nothing ever materializes? I have met dreamers with high ambitions but poor work skills. It takes hard work to succeed. Without good old fashioned hard work, success is rare to come. Hard work will eventually lead to profit. It usually does not happen quickly but persistence will pay off. Talking is lacking in actions. Just simply talking will lead only to poverty. Boasting of what a person can do but doing nothing will lead a man to begging.
