For I was very glad when brethren came and testified to your truth, that is, how you are walking in truth. I have no greater joy than this, to hear of my children walking in the truth. 3 John 3.4

In this short letter to Gaius, the aged apostle John shares these words about how he feels about fellow Christians who walk in truth. Let's consider a few facts from this passage when it comes to raising our youth for Christ.

**I.** There is truth and there is a lie. In a world that is sending confusing messages, we must help them to know the difference.

**II. John had no greater joy than to hear that his children walked in truth**. In this we see two things. One, John considered those in the church, even though they were not blood relatives, as his children. Let's love all of our young people as if they are our own. Secondly, let's assess where we find our greatest joy. Some would say I find no greater joy than to watch my child excel in athletics, band, academics, or in the financial world. All of these things will fade, but if our children walk in truth they will have an inheritance that will never fade. Children usually chase the things they see us treating as important so we must make sure we show them the importance of following God and His truth in all that we do. I'm looking forward to Sunday!

### No One Is Upright

Jeremiah 5:1 Go up and down the streets of Jerusalem, look around and consider, search through her squares. If you find but one person who deals honestly and seeks the truth, I will forgive this city.

How badly can a society stray from God? Israel was God's chosen nation. Jerusalem was the capital where kings lived in the palace and many of God's prophets resided. The people had grown far from God. God called his people unfaithful and asked them to return. The prophet had declared that a people from the north were coming because of Israel's unfaithfulness. Times were about to be terrible. The sad commentary about Jerusalem was that just one honest person who sought the truth could prevent the disaster but no one was found.

Jeremiah described the people like this. They swear falsely. Correction was refused. They would not repent. Their children have sworn by idols - false gods. Adultery was committed and they thronged to the houses of prostitution. Rebellion and backsliding was prominent. Jeremiah was given the responsibility to preach to these people and to announce the coming judgment against them. How did they respond?

The people called Jeremiah a liar. The prophets were simply bags of wind and Israel refused to accept their message. Wrongly, they believed the message was not God's word and they asked God to turn the prophet's message of doom on their own heads. Little did they know that Jeremiah spoke the truth and disaster was soon to come. God would punish them for their unfaithfulness. Christians, are we really listening to God's word? Are we comparing our behavior with the teachings of the Lord? Do we understand that eternal damnation exists? Do our lives truly honor the God of this universe? May we all seek him with all our heart.
