Restore Gently.... By Joe Macer

Galatians 6:1 Brothers, if someone is caught in a sin, you who are spiritual should restore him gently.

Scriptures clearly declare that all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. They also state that none are righteous. Christians have made the decision to turn away from sin. The decision has been made to live our life for Christ but this does not mean that we will no longer sin. Paul realized that Christians will sin. He also knows that many times it was not planned or premeditated. The person in this verse was caught in a sin. It is much like an animal that is caught in a trap. Little did he know that the decision would ensnare him. Christians do make mistakes. Failures do occur. Sin is not ok. Disciples of Jesus are expected to follow his teachings. Sin cannot be overlooked and sin must be repented from.

How are Christians to respond to the failings of others? Paul states that those who are spiritual should restore the person gently. We don't drive the offender away. We don't tell the person that they no longer are part of the church. We strive to find ways to help the individual to restore their relationship with the Lord. We do say that the sin is wrong but we quickly add "How can I help you?" People often are ashamed of their mistake and feel such a failure. Help them to understand that Christ does forgive and he greatly desires to be reconciled to the offender. Would we not want our brothers and sisters to do the same for us? We would not want a harsh response but a genuine show of concern and love. People do make mistakes. Will we help them recover from them? This verse teaches us to do so.
