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Forgiving Others

Be on your guard! If your brother sins, rebuke him; and if he repents, forgive him. And if he sins against you seven times a day, and returns to you seven times, saying, 'I repent,' forgive him." Luke 17:3,4

Jesus makes it clear that His disciples must be forgiving to others, but that does not make it easy. Pat Cook made a few observations as to why it is important to revisit how forgiving we are from time to time.

- 1) Being Unforgiving is **subtler** than most sins. It's sneaky. It crawls into your spirit so gently, so nobly, so innocently that you don't know it's there until it really has you.
- 2) It's also **more common** than most sins. We all battle it from time to time. Even though we may not stumble over the "bigger" sins, like the sins of the flesh, lack of forgiveness seems to affect more of us.
- 3) It's also **more dangerous** than most sins. It may not cause overdoses and car accidents, but it will divide churches, families, marriages, and nations. Being Unforgiving has been called the cancer of the soul. Unchecked, it will eat us alive.

Let each of us strive to forgive others as we have been forgiven.

Prevent An Argument

Proverbs 15:1 A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.

It might be in the checkout line at the grocery store. It might be in the parking lot at the mall. It might be the kid sitting next to you in school. It might be your coworker at lunch time. The scenes are varied and numerous. Someone says something and you do not like it or appreciate it. An assumption may be made that is incorrect. You may feel attacked. How do you react? How do you respond?

Solomon states there are two ways to respond. Yes, people can rub us wrong. Yes, some people can be obnoxious. But the truth is we are in control of our emotions and our response. We can return insults with insults. We can take what we consider an attack and return the attack. The results will be an escalation of the emotions - primarily anger. How many fights started with a few words and the fists began to fly? I once broke up a fight at school between two best friends. After separating them, they were extremely apologetic to each other and wanted their relationship restored. A few ugly words had the two rolling on the ground punching each other. Harsh words stir up anger.

The second way to respond is with a soft answer. A soft answer will have a calming effect. A soft answer will allow an actual conversation to take place. If there is a difference of opinion then a discussion can occur. Soft answers will allow friendships to continue and prevent the creation of an enemy. The soft answer is God's way. This is not always easy but this is what a Christian will strive to do. Will your next confrontation create more anger or turn away wrath?
