#### **Rumors**

Proverbs 15:2 The tongue of the wise commends knowledge, but the mouth of the fool gushes folly.

Did you know that Abraham Lincoln's body was exhumed twice? Was there any doubt about his method of death? No, there was no denying that John Wilkes Booth shot and killed the president. Then why was he exhumed? Twenty-two years after his death, his coffin was pried open to see if he was in it. Rumors had taken over the county so that people believed he was not there. He was in there and he was reburied. Fourteen years later he was dug up again. Why? Rumors were strongly circulating that he was not in the coffin again. His family strongly protested the exhuming and yet it occurred to lay to rest the rumors. To prevent this from happening again, he was placed in a steel cage ten feet deep covered with concrete. Rumors are not based on knowledge.

Our tongues can be used to spread knowledge or we can pass on information that has been invented by others. Solomon classifies this as folly. How often do we believe what has been told when it is not true? Phrases such as: have you heard - they say - did you hear - I was told - someone said - people believe - are usually passing on information that is not knowledge. Who are they? Who is the someone? Much of the information that is received from the internet and similar sources is not correct or is greatly slanted a particular direction. Political campaigns hire people to spin things in their direction and against their opponent. Creating rumors is their job. God's people should be in the business of spreading knowledge, not rumors. Question your sources about their statements. Let's not be found spreading folly. This would be especially true concerning our brothers and sisters. Let's have our facts straight before we begin to speak.
