I Timothy 4:13

The Power of God

Hebrews 4:12 For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

Our annual Bible reading will take place this week. This is an event that every member of South Gate can participate in. Christians are to be students of God's word and this is a special way in which we can be involved in reading God's message to us. Will you not set aside a time between Wednesday and Saturday to spend time reading within the South Gate building? Reading God's word will change our lives and will bring us closer to God. What does this verse teach that God's word will do for us?

The Word has cutting power and is capable of piercing a person's heart bringing about godly changes. One more thing the word of God is capable of doing is to judge our thoughts and attitudes. People do not know the human's motives but God's word will expose them especially on the day of judgment. With all this power, why not spend some extra time reading your Bible this week?
