Success

Proverbs 16:3 "Commit to the Lord whatever you do, and your plans will succeed."

Everyone wants to be a success, but just what is success? When I ask my students this question in class the most common answer is to have a lot of money in order to do whatever you want, whenever you want. The dictionary defines success as the favorable or prosperous termination of attempts or endeavors, the accomplishments of one's goals. With this thought, this verse ends by saying we will accomplish our goals. What are our goals? Solomon indeed was very successful at all that he did but what did he mean by this proverb? Does he mean that we will all be as rich as he was? Will we all be as wise as he was? Will we all have the fame, influence and high position that he had? Not for an instant do I believe that this is what he was saying. This proverb was written from the viewpoint of serving God. If we want to be a faithful servant of God then God will help us achieve this goal.

From the Christian perspective, if we want to be with God in heaven for eternity then it is very much possible. Our goal will be achieved but it does depend upon our commitment to the Lord. 
We rejoice with Karen Mann, who restored her life to Christ on Sunday morning and commend her for her desire to make her calling and election sure.
